

**C.K. McClatchy PTSA Minutes Summary**  
**September 2011**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Board members present included: Tim Kirn, Kate Sproul, Robin Imagire, Cathy Morrison, Lisa Giroux

Principal Lambert's report included the following:

- CKM is the largest school in SCUSD with over 2,300 students;
- Need to hire more staff;
- Extensive list of AP courses, increasing academies, HISP, and ROTC;
- Increasing classes for English Learners;
- 0 period and 7<sup>th</sup> period classes for credit recovery;
- Enrichment classes;
- The school and surrounding neighborhoods and businesses will be dealing in the next several months with traffic issues along Freeport Blvd;
- Increasing STAR test scores;
- This year is the school's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary – will include city and neighborhood in upcoming events.

Jocelyn Gutierrez, counselor with the College and Career Center, gave an update regarding the services available to students and parents at the center.

Lilly Williams was appointed as chair of the Reflection Committee – one of the largest student art competitions. This year's theme "Diversity Means . . ."

Teacher Jennifer Graziano requested volunteers for her block algebra class; contact Kate Sproul if you are available.

Kathryn Tobias is requesting volunteers to sit at front office desk, shifts from 8 to 12 and 12 to 4.

May minutes moved and approved.

Treasurer's report: moved and second to ratify checks paid over the summer; looking to start PayPal; moved and second to pass audit report and the 7/1/11 budget through 6/30/12 budget.

Robin Imagire, membership chair, gave an update regarding members which currently count 318.
